- 2. One piece driving suit meeting SFI 3.2A/5 or FIA 8856-2000, or a single layer suit meeting SFI 3.2A/1 with fire retardant underwear
- 3. Fire retardant shoes meeting SFI 3.3/5 or FIA 8856-2000
- 4. Gloves, socks and balaclava (if needed) meeting SFI 3.3/5 or FIA 8856-2000
- 5. Approved head and neck restraint device meeting SFI 38.1 or FIA 8858 is required for all () USA drivers at all driving/racing events in 2012

Car Information

All Porsche 996/997 GT3 Cup cars must comply as outlined in Pirelli GT3 Cup Trophy USA West technical specification matrix (See Rules and Regulations at www.competentms.com)

Check to Certify:

- 1. A 5 or 6 point seat belt that meets rule requirements for width, dated no older than 5 years, with no frays or cuts, and mounted correctly with bayonet clips pinned
- 2. Window net properly mounted (optional)
- 3. Fire extinguisher, properly mounted
- 4. Cut off switch and decal, properly mounted and functional
- 5. Roll cage (factory) if approved size and design with roll bar sticker in place
- 6. Seat meets rule requirements
- 7. Brake lights are highly visible
- 8. Rear view mirrors
- 9. Windshield sage, no visible cracks
- 10. Numbers and Class designation of proper size in correct locations
- 11. Steel lug nuts with sufficient engagement on center-lock nuts with safety pins inserted
- 12. Roll bar padding in needed locations
- 13. All hoods and doors with sufficient latching mechanisms
- 14. No oil, fuel, coolant or brake fluid leaks; all fuel lines in good conditions
- 15. Battery must be bolted down
- 16. All ballasts in driving compartment are adequately bolted down
- 17. Overall mechanical and cosmetic condition satisfactory
- 18. Car meets all criteria of racing 2012 Race Group
- 19. **All Pirelli GT3 Cup Trophy USA West and Partner logos in proper location at all times during event**
