Rule Amendments	<p>The sections listed below are rule amendments and/or additions to the current 2018 General & Sporting Rules and Technical Regulations. We have identified which rules are changes to the existing referenced section or a new section to be added.</p> <p>Add Section 16.10 to Technical Regulations: 16.10 Aerodynamic Aids:</p> <p>991.1 16.10.1 The use of clear or black tape to cover the central cooler, affixed to the radiator opening screen, in horizontal line to regulate the water temperature is permitted. Provided the central cooler is completely taped, additional tape may be added in similar horizontal and symmetrical fashion to the left and right side coolers. Otherwise the taping over of body slots and openings is not allowed.</p> <p>16.10.2 With the exception of what is stated in section V15.7 5.2.7 of the Technical Regulations, the use of tape to cover any mechanical components or adjustments is prohibited.</p> <p>991.2 and 981 16.10.3 The use of tape or any material to cover the radiator openings is prohibited. Taping over of body slots and openings is not allowed.</p> <p>16.10.4 With the exception of what is stated in section V15.7 5.2.7 of the Technical Regulations, The use of tape to cover any mechanical components or adjustments is prohibited.</p>

Notifications	<p><u>Notice #1 Liftgates:</u> For all events it is recommended that liftgates be in the closed position when not in use. When in use, place traffic cones around the parameter with a team member directing traffic as needed.</p> <p><u>Notices #2 Fuel handling/fire extinguishers:</u> Fuel handling in garages not allowed. Fire extinguishers to be present during fuel handling.</p> <p><u>Notice #3 CMS to team radio communications:</u> Pit to Car Voice Radios:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Required in all phases of competition.• All competitors are required to monitor Competent Motorsport Race Control frequency, 461.2000 DPL 432• At all times that the Car is on the racetrack, a minimum of one (1) crewmember in the Pit Box must have radio communication with the Driver. At all times during a Session, a minimum of one (1) crewmember in the Pit Box must monitor the published Race Control frequency
