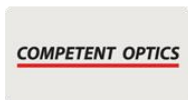

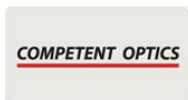

North Palm and Desert Circuit 2.7 mile

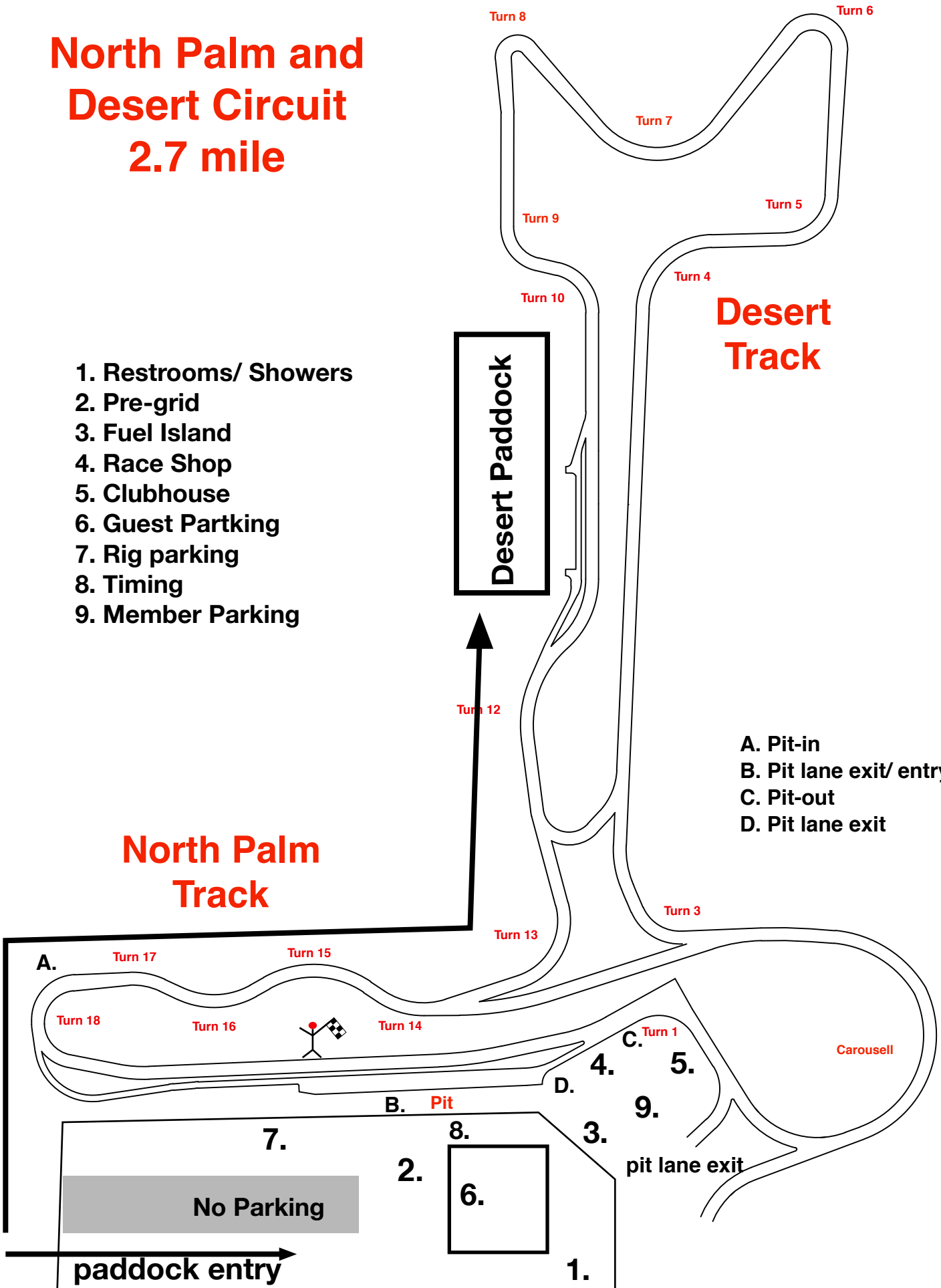

Appendix C

On-Track Policies and General Information

Sound Restrictions: The Thermal Club has a noise curfew between the hours of 7pm and 7am. On track noise is limited to 106db measured at 50ft from the track edge.

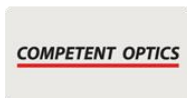
On-Track Scheduling: Groups may not schedule any track activity prior to 7am or after 7pm. That includes slow laps on the road course for track familiarization. All track activity must take place between 7am and 7pm. Prior to 7am only maintenance, safety and other track preparation vehicles (corner workers, course staff, communication, etc) are allowed on course.

Oil/Hazardous Material Spills: In the case of an oil or hazardous material spill please contact the Thermal Club maintenance and track department immediately.

Pit Lane Restrictions: Only event participants and track personnel (safety, corner workers, course marshals, etc.) are allowed in pit lane while the track is HOT. Credentialed media and photographers are also allowed in cold pit lane. Course marshals, photographers and media must be easily identified. All personnel must follow the guidelines listed below.

- Must be 16 years or older
- Shorts, sleeveless shirts or open-toed shoes are not permitted
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted
- No pets
- Crew Chiefs, team members, officials, etc. must stay in cold pit lane at all times
- Under no circumstances may a team member go on to the track to assist safety personnel

Fueling at Thermal Club: Fuel is available for purchase at the east end of the main paddock. the fuel pumps accept CC payment.

Pit Lane Fueling- for race cars only and must be done with an additional person holding a fire extinguisher.

Fuel Spills- ALL spills need to be reported to Thermal track personnel immediately. Damages and cost of cleanup can apply.

Power Cords, Generators: Power cord may not be plugged in to any building on property for non- race use. Power is available in the paddock for an additional charge. generators are available for rent by contacting Thermal
