Rule Amendments	<p>The sections listed below are rule amendments and/or additions to the current 2019 General and Sporting Rules, and Technical Regulations. We have identified which rules are changes to the existing referenced section or a new section to be added.</p> <p>No Rule Amendments for Weather Tech Raceway Laguna Seca,</p>
Notifications	<p><u>Notice #1 Liftgates:</u> For all events it is recommended that liftgates be in the closed position when not in use. When in use, place traffic cones around the parameter with a team member directing traffic as needed.</p>
WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca Sound Procedure and General Paddock Rules	<p><u>Sound Procedure Utilized for the Event</u> Vehicles that hit or exceed 105db as measured by the WTLS sound monitoring equipment, will be black flagged and immediately removed from the track and cannot complete that session. The competitor is asked to modify the exhaust or sound issue on the vehicle. A 2nd sound violation follows the same procedure, a 3rd sound violation for the same vehicle excludes the competitor from the remainder of the weekend.</p> <p><u>General Paddock Rules</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pit vehicles must be operated by a licensed driver 18 years or older • 10 MPH speed limit in Paddock and Pit areas • Dogs are NOT allowed in the Paddock • If leaving the Paddock on a motorcycle/scooter you must wear a helmet • Private golf carts, transporting passengers around the facility, must be registered and a permit must be affixed to the golf cart by SCRAMP • Private and rental golf carts must submit a liability insurance certificate for \$1,000,000.00 in coverage in order to operate at the facility • Pit Carts being used exclusively for Team support in the Paddock and are not capable of carrying passengers do not need to be registered • Drones: The Laguna Seca Recreational Area is considered a NO Drone Zone

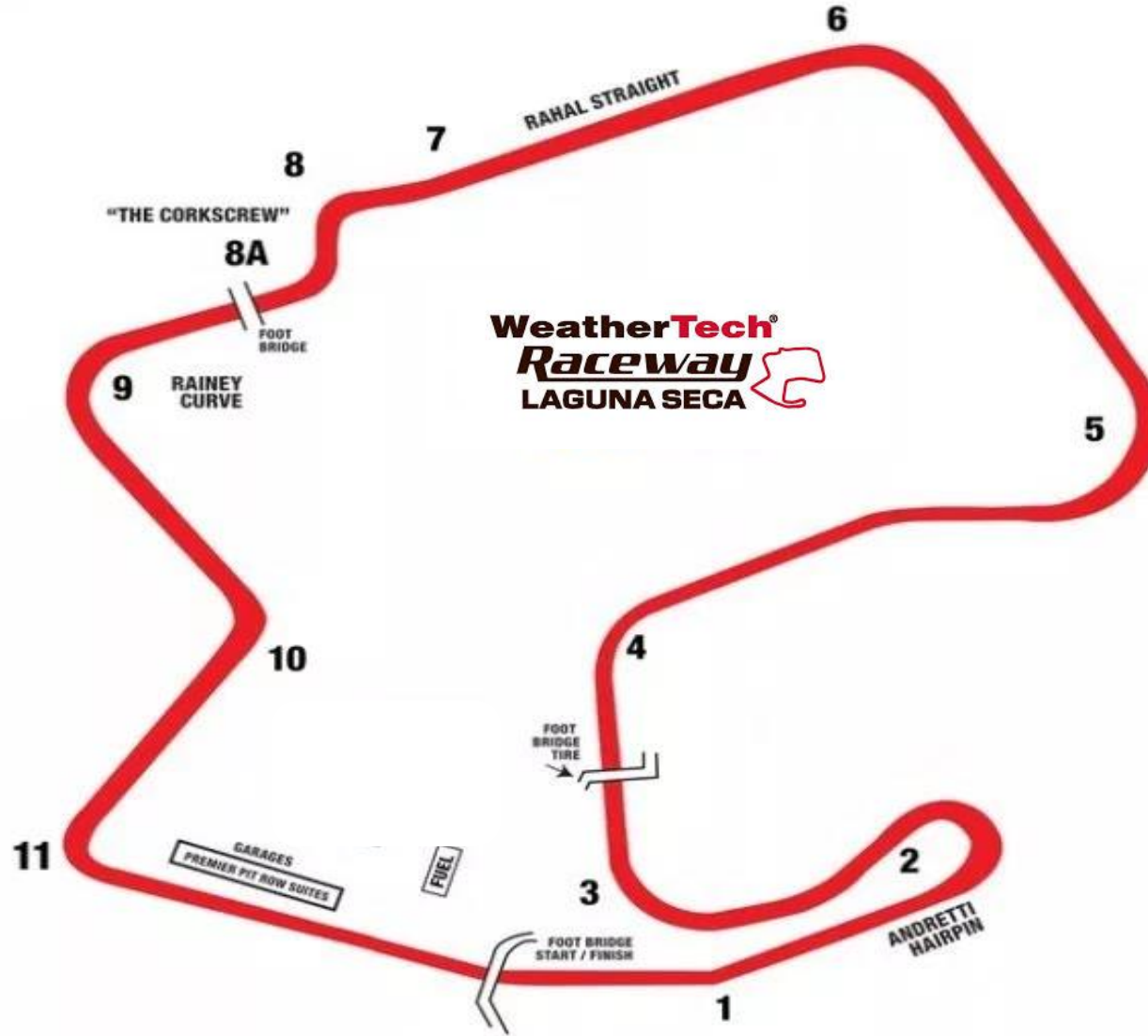
